

FRUIT TREES

APPLES

All apples are grown on S-M7 semi-dwarfing rootstock. Trees bear regular size fruit 4-5 years after planting. Plant 2 different varieties for pollination.

Honeycrisp

#5 approx. 6' tall

Exceptionally crisp and juicy, sweet but well-balanced flavor. Excellent storage life, up to 7 months. Ripens in late September. Outstanding commercial and home orchard variety. Needs a different pollinator. Grows 12-15' tall and 14' wide.

Honeygold

#5 approx. 6' tall

Cross between 'Golden Delicious' and 'Haralson'. Medium to large yellow fruit is crisp, juicy and sweet. Excellent for eating and cooking. Medium storage life. Hardier than Golden Delicious. Needs a different pollinator. Grows 12-15' and 14' wide; ripens early October.

SnowSweet®

#5 approx. 6' tall

A mid season apple that has a deliciously sweet, slightly tart taste. Slow to oxidize when exposed to air. Excellent for fresh eating and cooking. Honeycrisp is a good pollinator. Ripens mid-late September. Resistant to scab and fireblight. Grows 12-15'x14' wide.

Sweet Sixteen

#5 approx. 6' tall

Medium-sized red striped apple with crisp, juicy texture. Excellent sweet, unusual flavor. Outstanding dessert apple. Fireblight resistant. Ripens in mid-September. Grows 12-15' tall and 14' wide.

Triple Play

3-in-1 #10 approx. 6' tall

Three mid-season blooming apple trees in one container to form a clump. Good for pollinating, extended harvest, and assortment of varieties. Honeycrisp, Sweet 16, and Cortland. All good for eating and cooking. Grows 12-15' tall and 14' wide. Ripens mid-late September.

CHERRY - TART OR SOUR

#5 approx. 6' tall

Mesabi

Long stemmed, red-fleshed fruits with sugar content halfway between pie cherries and sweet cherries. Grows to 12' tall. Small pit, large bright red fruit. Self-fruitful. Ripens early July.

North Star

Natural dwarf with red fruit with a small stone; very productive. Sour pie cherry. Self pollinating, grows 8-10'. Ripens early July.

CHERRY - SWEET

#5 approx. 6' tall

Lapin

Beautiful dark mahogany red cherry. Large, juicy, sweet taste wonderful for baking and cooking. Highly resistant to browning. Self-fruitful. Grows 15-20' tall. Ripens in July-August.

PEAR

Summercrisp

#5 approx. 6' tall

Very hardy, free of fireblight, an annual bearer. 2.5-3" diameter fruit, 3-3.5" long. Harvest in mid-August when crisp and still green with a red blush. May be stored up to 2 months. Use Parker as a pollinator. Semi-dwarf, grows 15' tall.

Parker

#5 approx. 6' tall

Open-pollinated seedling of a Manchurian pear. Large, yellow-bronze fruit. Fine grained, tender and juicy. Upright and vigorous grower. Requires pollinator. Ripens in August. 25' tall.

PEACH

Redhaven

#5 approx. 6' tall

One of the finest early peaches. Flesh is firm, smooth textured, fine flavored. Medium size, round fruit; freestone. Good for freezing, canning, and shipping. Disease resistant and very hardy. Fruit sets heavily and must be thinned. Ripens in July-early August. 10-15'. Self pollinating.
